The State of Minnesota has authorized local public school districts to:

1. Loan textbooks, standardized tests, and individualized instructional materials to pupils attending nonpublic and home schools, established and operating within the school district boundaries. These materials must be secular in nature, designed primarily for individual use by the pupil in a particular class or program in the school the pupil regularly attends.
2. Allows access to the existing district Pupil Health Service Programs.
3. Allows access to the existing district Secondary Pupil Guidance and Counseling Services programs

This pupil request form must be completed and filed on behalf of the student no later than September 22, 2017. This form must be completed for each student listed below who receives aid in one or more of these areas during the 2017-18 academic years. If you do not want to participate in the Nonpublic Education Aid please sign and return this form to the nonpublic school.

Your nonpublic school administrator will help you properly complete the form and will keep this form on file to document student eligibility for educational aid.
